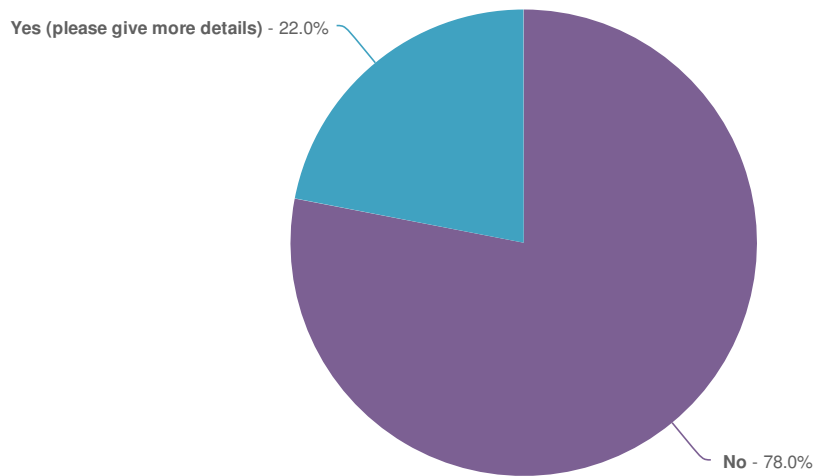
13. On a scale of 1 to 10, how well do you think the PaCC represents the views of parent carers in the city? (10 being brilliant, 1 being not well at all)
