PaCC is a forum representing parent carers of children or young people with additional needs and/or disabilities who use key services provided by Brighton & Hove.

We work with statutory organisations that provide services to parent carers. We aim to help raise and maintain the standard of support available and maximise our children's opportunities to flourish.

- **Parent Representatives:** We have a Steering Group made up of parent carers who sit on strategic decision making boards to provide a parent perspective to the way in which services are planned, delivered and evaluated.
- **Regular reports and position statements** on key issues shared on social media.
- **Focus Groups and events:** Bringing together parent carers with senior managers from the local authority and healthcare for PaCCConnect meetings, a chance to raise issues and concerns and discuss directly with key representatives.
- **PaCC blog:** News and articles shared via our website, mailing list and Amaze's newsletter.
