Pacc is a forum representing parent carers of children or young people with additional needs and/or disabilities who use key services provided by Brighton & Hove.


We work with statutory organisations that provide services to parent carers. We aim to help raise and maintain the standard of support available and maximise our children's opportunities to flourish.
